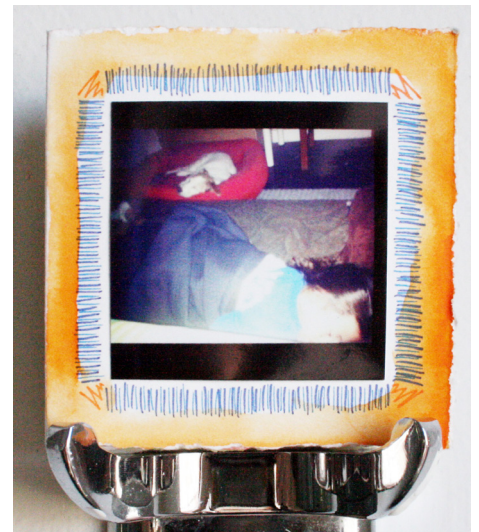

8. Use a rubber band to hold your book shut if it's going into your purse. Use a ribbon if it's going on a shelf.

There are more photos on the next page....



1. Start with a piece of hot press watercolor paper cut to 3"x15" and score it along the 15" side, every 3 inches.
2. Accordion fold the paper along the score lines to create a book with five panels.
3. You'll be using nine photos – each one is 2"x2" – so with a pencil, lightly trace a 2"x2" square onto each of the panels.
4. Doodle a frame around each square. Alternate using colored Pigma Microns and black Pigma Microns. I used two sizes of the pens: .01 and .05.
5. Use the Sakura Koi watercolor set to add additional color to each of the panels. Because the Pigma Microns are permanent and waterproof, the ink will not smear when it gets wet.
6. Adhere your photos to all but the front panel.
7. On the front panel add your
