


Sakura Lettering Layout

I recommend that everyone practice lettering before starting this layout. Remember to hold the Pigma Calligrapher as vertical as possible.

- 1. Place a 4"x4" photo on a 12"x12" piece of smooth white card-
- 2. Use a Sakura SumoGrip Pencil to lightly sketch an outline around the perimeter of the layout and a flower with three leaves.
- 3. Use a .05 Sakura Pigma Micron to trace the pencil lines. Erase the pencil lines.
- 4. Draw stripes into the border.
- 5. Color the border and flower with the Sakura Pigma Brush pens.

- 6. Use a black Sakura Pigma Brush pen to add a shadow to the border and flowers.
- 7. Use a Sakura Pigma Brush pen to write your title.
- 8. Use a black Sakura Pigma Brush pen to add a shadow to the title.
- 9. Adhere your photo to the layout.
- 10. Use a Sakura SumoGrip Pencil to draw lines for your journaling. Start at the top and bottom of the title and work out from there.
- 11. Use a .05 Sakura Pigma Micron to write your journaling, pausing every now and then to write an important word with a Pigma Calligrapher 30.
- 12. Erase your pencil lines
