


## Sakura Stenciled Layout

- 1. Use tape to mark which parts of the Balzer Designs "Wedding Ring" stencil you want to use.
- 2. Use a .05 Pigma Micron to trace the stencil design.
- 3. Remove the stencil and color in the center area with a Sakura Glaze Pen.
- 4. Rip two pieces of deli paper and layer them on top of one another.
- Use a piece of washi tape to adhere your photo to the two pieces of deli paper.
- 6. Adhere the deli paper and photo to the bottom left corner of your layout.
- 7. Stamp the number 2 onto a piece of deli paper. Give the ink a moment to dry.
- 8. Finish the curve of the number 2 and color in the empty stripe with a Sakura Soufflé Pen.
- Write the word "girls" on deli paper in script using a Sakura Soufflé Pen. Let the ink dry.
- 10. Once the ink is dry, outline the word with a .01 Pigma Micron.
- 11. Cut out both the number and the word and layer them. Then





- adhere them both to the layout.
- 12. Add two hand cut strips of paper to the top of the layout.
- 13. Add your journaling.
- 14. Splash black watercolor droplets across the layout and you're done!
