Eco Green Crafts Project by Julie Fei-Fan Balzer



- 1. Paint both pages with a generous coating of Melon Eco Green Crafts acrylic paint.
- 2. While the paint is wet press ripped book pages into it. The paint will act as an adhesive.
- 3. Once the paint is dry, apply a mix of White Eco Green Crafts acrylic paint and water over the entire surface.
- 4. While the paint is still wet rub Coral Eco Green Crafts acrylic paint into portions of the page. Add more White as necessary.
- Once the paint is dry, water down some Black Eco Green Crafts acrylic paint and add splats across the page.
 Lot day
- 6. Let dry.
- 7. Paint two medium sized Eco Green Crafts Embellishing Die Cuts (Circles) with Coral and Primary Yellow Eco Green Crafts acrylic paint. The yellow should be the final layer.
- 8. Let dry.
- 9. Once dry, cut the circles in half with scissors.
- 10. Color the edges of the circles with a black crayon and smudge a bit.
- 11. Adhere Eco Green Crafts Black Glass

Glintz to the spread in groupings. Use Eco Green Crafts All-Purpose Green Glue.

- Adhere photos (slightly smaller than 3"x3") to spread and then yellow half-circles over the photos. Use Eco Green Crafts All-Purpose Green Glue.
- 13. Using a very small paintbrush, paint

your journaling onto the remaining space on the page and you're done!
