

SPRINGTIME IN PARIS Wall Mounts



Start with a 12” square foam wall mount.

Cut a burlap square, 16” x 16”.



Lay the burlap square wrong side up on the table. Place the foam wall mount in the middle of the burlap.



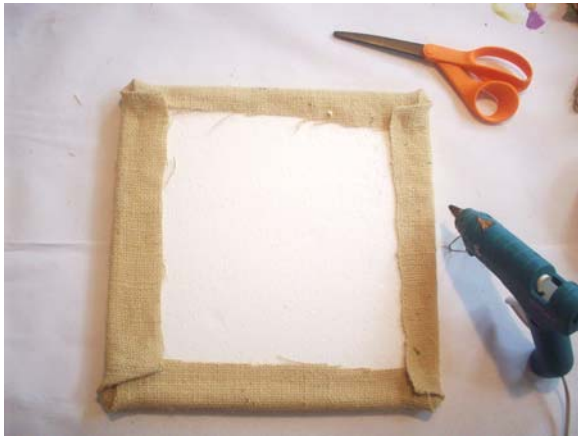
MITRE the corners by cutting off 1-1/2” in from the tip of each corner.



Apply Glue to one corner, wrap the burlap and adhere to the foam. Repeat for each corner.

Wrap and adhere each side to the foam; pulling the burlap taught as glue is applied.



Cut and glue an 11" square of burlap to the back to conceal the foam and raw edges. Turn over, right side facing up.

Choose the background paper. Cut 1/2" from each of the four sides to make it 11" square.

Using a wedge sponge, **pounce** the sponge on the ink pad, then apply to the edges of the memory paper.

Center and adhere the memory paper to the burlap as shown in the photo given.

Embellishing the board:

Cut an 8" Eiffel tower from brown paper in the paper stack. Cut a shadow piece from a contrasting paper. (Black paper was used here.)

Cut out the elements of tags, postcards, etc. from the embellishment page in the paper stack.

Letters: Choose a contrasting paper (brown for this design). Using a pencil, trace around each letter onto the wrong side of the paper. Cut out the paper letters, match edges and adhere to the wooden letters.

Shade the edges of each letter using the ink and sponge.

Finish: Arrange and position the embellishments to the page. Adhere.

Flowers: Poke the flowers into desired position with the tack hook in the "upright" position. Poke remaining glittered tackz into the board.
