



Sakura Altered Cards

1. Color the flower and square on the store bought stationery with Sakura Glaze Pens.
2. Once the pens have dried, outline the flower and square with Sakura Souffle Pens.
3. Adhere a strip of patterned paper to the bottom of the stationery to finish it off.

Note: With both the Sakura Glaze and Souffle pens I like to get the ink flowing on a piece of scrap paper before I color.



1. Color the embossed (raised) flower design on the store bought card with Sakura Glaze Pens. You can let the pens dry and build up even more dimension with multiple layers of coloring.
2. Trace the "Thank You" sentiment with a Sakura Souffle pen.

1. Use Sakura Souffle pens to add polka dots to the background of the card, color in the frame, add centers to the flowers, and stripes to the leaves.
2. Once the ink is dry, use Sakura Glaze pens to color in the sentiment, some of the flowers and some of the leaves.
