



LACE POP UP CARDS

Supplies:

- Brother ScanNCut
- White Cardstock
- Paper Trimmer
- Scor-It
- Ruler (optional)
- DCWV Cardstock Stack Brights
- Adhesive

Instructions:

1. Choose or create a design that touches the sides, but not the top or bottom of a rectangle.
2. Scan the design into the Brother ScanNCut.
3. Use the scan function to “see” the white cardstock you’re going to cut the design out of. Move the design so that it is generally centered on the white cardstock.
4. Cut the design. I have found that a blade length of 4 is gen-



- erally right for cardstock.
5. Using a Scor-It (and a ruler if desired) carefully score the cut design down the center.
6. Trim the cardstock to 10” wide by 7” tall, being sure that the scored center line remains exactly in the center. If it isn’t exactly in the center of your 10”, the card won’t fold properly.
7. Carefully start the folding process, coaxing the cut area in one direction and the remainder of the seam in the opposite direction. You will also need to gently fold the areas of the cut section that touch the edge of the rectangle.
8. Once everything is folded, fold the card in half and smooth.
9. Cut a piece of colored cardstock from the DCWV Cardstock Stack Brights to 10x7.”
10. Score the colored cardstock in the center of the 10” side – creating a second card.
11. Layer the pop up card with the colored cardstock. Adhere the two parts together, being sure to do it in the card closed position. Otherwise, the pop up won’t work and/or the card won’t fold properly.
