



DOODLED CARD PAGE

Supplies:

- Black Cardstock cut to 3x4
- Sakura Gelly Roll Moonlight Pens
- Adhesive
- 2 3x4 photos
- 12x12 white cardstock
- DCWV Whimsical World Stack
- Scissors
- Brother ScanNCut
- typewriter
- Embroidery Floss
- Paper Piercer
- Embroidery Floss & Needle
- Optional: Washi Tape

Instructions:

1. Start with the word "who" in the quote "I think I like who I am becoming." Using the Sakura Gelly Roll Moonlight pens, draw the outline of the word on the black cardstock. Then draw circles inside the letters. Then fill in the circles.
2. Next do the yellow words above and below the word "who." Write the words in uppercase printing and then fatten them up.
3. Change colors and do the word "becoming" the same way.
4. Use cursive handwriting for the first line "I think" and fatten it up the same way you did with the uppercase printing.

5. Add simple doodles to the top and bottom of the black cardstock.
6. Adhere the two photos and the lettered card to the white cardstock.
7. Use scissors to cut a scalloped strip from the polka dot and glittered patterned paper from the DCWV Whimsical World Stack. Adhere it underneath the photos and quote card.
8. Fussy cut two leaves from the DCWV Whimsical World Stack.
9. Use the Direct Cut mode on the Brother ScanNCut to cut out the journaling card from the DCWV Whimsical World Stack.
10. Add journaling to the journaling card using a typewriter.
11. Adhere the journaling card and the leaves to the layout.



12. Use a paper piercer to poke holes wherever you'd like to add stitching. I like to secure the ends of my stitching by taping them to the back of the layout with washi tape.
