



CUT OUT CARDS

Supplies:

- DCWV Jewel/Bijou Box of Cards
- DCWV Solid Glitter Box of Cards – Brights
- DCWV Solid Glitter Box of Cards – Neutrals
- DCWV Citrus Box of Cards
- DCWV Box of Cards - Brights
- Brother ScanNCut
- Tape Runner
- Sakura Quickie Glue Pen
- Cutting Mat
- Craft Knife
- Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Favorite Punches
- Optional: rhinestones, layered embellishments, DCWV Metallic Papers, stamps, stamping ink, typewriter, vellum or deli paper

Instructions:

There are several ways to create a design for the front of your card using the Brother ScanNCut:

1. Draw a design, either by hand or on the computer.
2. Use existing designs in the Brother ScanNCut, including text.
3. Cut up paper to create a design – it can be very simple or quite complicated.



You can also use a craft knife and cutting mat to create your own designs, or use your favorite punches!

Once you have cut your design, you can create all sorts of variations:

1. **Mom Heart Card:** The word “Mom” was stamped inside the cut out heart. A balloon string was added with a Sakura Pigma Micron.
2. **Love You Card:** Metallic hearts were added to the “Os” using DCWV Foiled Cardstock Stack. Each heart is actually two hearts, glued back-to-back.
3. **Orange Thank You Card:** The sentiment “thank you”

was typed in the opening with a typewriter.

4. **Hello Card:** The cut out design was backed with DCWV Foiled Cardstock. “Hello” was cut from a scrap of the same cardstock and adhered to the front of the card.
5. **Happy Birthday Card:** The opening was backed with deli paper. You could also use vellum.
