

## ONE CUT/TWO PROJECTS

## Supplies:

- DCWV The Metallic Stack
- Brother ScanNCut
- Scissors
- Sakura Quickie Glue Pen
- 2 Sheets of White Cardstock 12x12
- Tape Runner
- three 2.25x2.25" photos
- Black Rhinestones
- Marker & Piece of Paper
- Black Cardstock
- Sakura Pigma Micron
- DCWV The Bella Armoire Stack
- Chalk Inks pink, blue, yellow
- Koi Watercolor
- Paintbrush
- Container of Water
- 4x4" photo
- Paper Trimmer (optional)
- Paper Feather (tutorial for making your own: <a href="http://tinyurl.com/qetcotq">http://tinyurl.com/qetcotq</a>)
- Paper Piercer & Mouse Pad
- Embroidery Floss
- Needle

## Instructions: Layout 1

- 1. Cut out at least 14 leaves (from the built-in quilting designs on the Brother ScanNCut) from a sheet of DCWV Metallic paper.
  - a. Use the scan function in order to "see" the small piece of paper on the cutting mat.
  - b. Gather the leaves so that they can all be cut



from that single piece of paper.

- From a separate sheet of DCWV Metallic paper, use a pair of scissors to cut out two parentheses-like shapes.
- 3. Adhere the parentheses-like shapes to the white cardstock, using the Quickie Glue Pen.
- 4. Adhere the leaves to the parentheses-like shapes.
- 5. Adhere three 2.25x2.25" photos down the center of the leaf fronds you've created.
- 6. Add three black rhinestones at the base of the photos.
- 7. Write your title on a piece of paper with a black marker. Scan it into the Brother ScanNCut machine and cut it out of black cardstock.
- 8. Adhere the title to your layout using the Quickie Glue Pen.
- 9. Add your journaling.
- 10. Cut a strip of paper from the DCWV Bella Armoire Stack and adhere it along the left edge of the layout.

**Instructions: Layout 2** 

- 1. Use the negative space from the leaf cut-outs from the previous layout as a stencil. Rub three colors of chalk inks through the stencil, moving it around and even overlapping previously stenciled areas.
- 2. Add a splattering of black watercolor splats. Let dry or dry with a heat gun.
- 3. Adhere a 4x4" photo to the layout.
- 4. Trim the negative space of the previous layout's title to a tidy rectangle and adhere it to the layout. You can use scissors or a paper trimmer.
- 5. Adhere three black rhinestones under the title.
- 6. Add your journaling.
- 7. Attach a paper feather to your layout with embroidery floss. You can buy paper feathers or make your own. I use a paper piercer and mouse pad to create holes for my stitching.
