

## HOT GLUE STENCILS

## Supplies:

- Ad Tech Hi-Temp Project Pro Glue Gun
- Ad Tech 2 Temp Glue Gun
- Ad Tech Multi Temp Glitter Mini Gluesticks
- Ad Tech Multi Temp Full Size Gluesticks
- Optional: Ad Tech Finger Guards
- Teflon Craft Sheet
- 12x12 Watercolor Paper
- Mist (yellow and red)
- DCWV Sweet Blossom Stack
- 3x2.5" photo
- Brother ScanNCut
- DCWV Cardstock Stack Brights
- Paintbrush small
- Mini mouse pad
- Quickie Glue Pen
- Adhesive
- Scissors

## **Instructions:**

1. Working on a teflon craft sheet, draw a simple design with Ad Tech 2 Temp Glue Gun. I find the hi-temp works a bit better than the low temp. You want your design to be attached in multiple places, so that it holds together





when you pull it up from the craft sheet.

- 2. Switch to the Ad Tech Hi-Temp Project Pro Glue Gun. Load the gun with blue glitter glue. Working on a teflon craft sheet, create several small dots of color.
- 3. Continue to draw designs for later projects until you've used up all the blue glitter glue. Switch to red glitter glue and working on a teflon craft sheet, draw the scallop embellishment.
- 4. Let the glue cool.
- 5. Once the glue is cool, carefully pull your Ad Tech hot glue stencil off the mat. Place the stencil(s) onto a sheet of watercolor paper and spray with spray ink. Move the stencil around as you desire.
- 6. Let dry or dry with a heat gun.
- 7. Remove the tag paper from the DCWV Sweet Blossom Stack. Cut several tags from the sheet.
- 8. From the largest tag, cut out a triangle to create a pennant shape.
- 9. Layer the tags together, along with a photograph.

- 10. Add the word "me" and your title, both cut using the Brother ScanNCut. The "me" was created using fonts found in the machine and cut from a piece of patterned paper from the DCWV Sweet Blossom Stack. The title was written on a piece of paper and scanned into the Brother ScanNCut. It was then cut from blue cardstock from the DCWV Cardstock Stack Brights.
- 11. Adhere a strip of patterned paper from the DCWV Sweet Blossom Stack to the edge of the layout.
- 12. Fussy cut two flowers from a piece of the DCWV Sweet Blossom Stack.
- 13. Place the flowers on top of a mini mouse pad and use the end of a paintbrush to create dimension.
- 14. Adhere the two flowers on top of each other, and then to the page.
- 15. Remove the hot glue scallop from the teflon sheet and adhere it the layout.
- 16. Remove the blue glitter glue dots from the teflon sheet. Adhere one to the center of the layered flower. Adhere several other dots around the layout.
