

## SUPPLIES

- white cardstock 12x12
- acrylic paint
- paint palette
- \* scissors
- cosmetic sponges
- \* Balzer Designs "4 Feathers" stencil 12x12 from The Crafter's Workshop
- typewriter
- \* stamp
- \* permanent ink
- \* paper trimmer
- \* pencil
- \* ruler
- \* eraser
- black pen
- \* post its
- \* photograph 2.75x2.75 with a white border
- \* adhesive

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use an up and down motion with a cosmetic sponge and a thin layer of acrylic paint to stencil the open section of the Crafter's Workshop "4 Feathers" stencil using 3 different, coordinating, colors of paint. Feel free to flip the stencil over to make the feathers move in the opposite direction. To change paint colors you can simply snip off the end of the cosmetic sponge. There's a very short drying time as you're applying an extremely thin layer of paint.
- Using a darker color, stencil the more "feath-

ery" designs on top of the colorful feathers you've already stenciled. Use post its or scraps of paper to mask off the areas you don't want stenciled. Stencil the "top" feather first and then add the dark outlines to the others.

- 3. Trim the photograph so that it looks like a Polaroid -- small white border on the top and both sides and a learger one on the bottom.
- 4. Use a typewriter to type

- your title onto the bottom white section of the photo.
- 5. Stamp across the remaining area of the white bottom section with a simple dash stamp.
- 6. Adhere the photo to the layout.
- 7. Use a pencil and a ruler to lightly draw lines above and below the photo.
- 8. Add your journaling with a black pen.
- 9. Erase the pencil lines and you're done!
