
Scrapbook Soup TV Project Instructions

SUPPLIES

- * patterned paper 12x12
- black cardstock
- * white cardstock
- * paper trimmer
- tape runner
- * 1 4x6 photo
- * 1 4x6 quote on black background
- * scissors
- Sakura Moonlight Pens in regular and fine point
- * Optional: sewing machine

INSTRUCTIONS

 Use a combination of the regular and fine point Sakura Moon-





light Pens to doodle on a piece of black cardstock.

- Cut two strips of the doodled cardstock (approximately l" wide, but it's nice if you cut a little wonky).
- 3. Using the fine point Sakura Moonlight Pens, add a shadow to the quote/title of your page.
- 4. Again, using the fine point Sakura Moonlight Pens, add journaling to your photo.
- 5. Use a tape runner to adhere the photo and the quote/title to the white cardstock with a small gap in the middle.
- 6. Trim the white cardstock to leave a small white border around the photo and quote.
- 7. Adhere the white cardstock in the center of the patterned paper.
- 8. Adhere the two strips of doodled cardstock together using a tape runner.
- 9. Fold the long strip you've created back and forth to create messy pleats. You can adhere it to the layout with a tape runner or by stitching a line straight down the middle with a sewing machine. And you're done!
