INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use black watercolor paint and a soft brush to paint a circle and your title. You can also splash some paint dots. TIP: Spray your watercolors with water to get them nice and juicy before you paint. Let dry or dry with a heat gun.
- 2. Doodle flowers using a Sakura Pigma Micron .08 on a book page.
- 3. Using the Koi Coloring Brush markers, color the centers of the flowers yellow. Use two shades of blue to color the petals. The blues will blend for a painterly look if you work quickly.
