

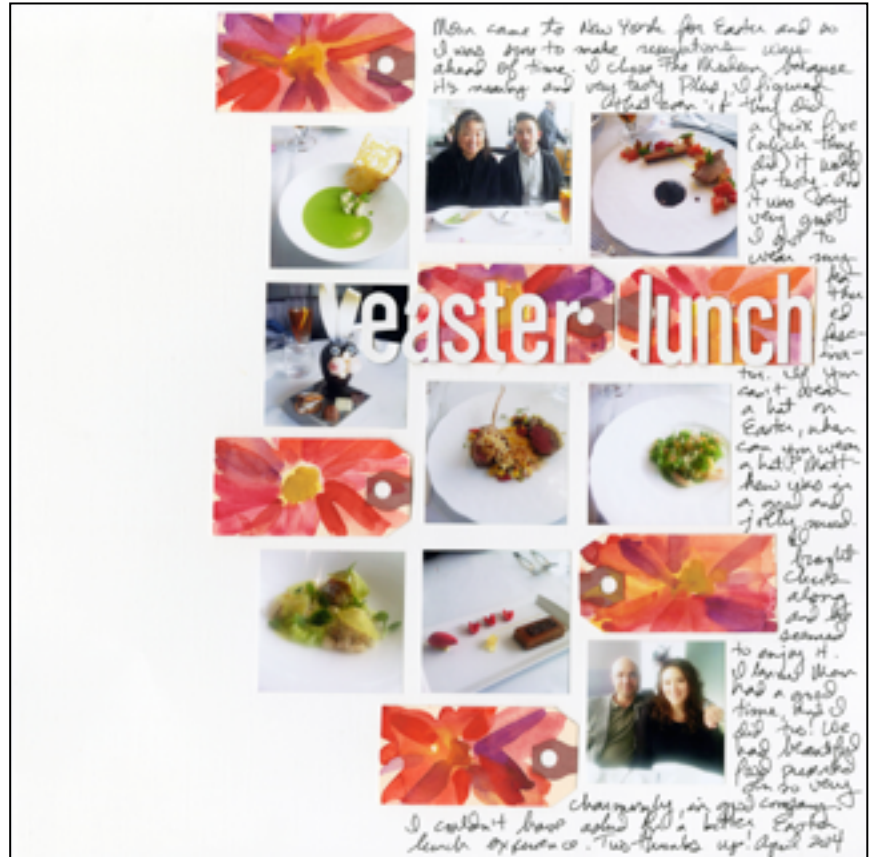
Easter Watercolor Tag Scrapbook Page

SUPPLIES

- * white cardstock 12x12
- * white letter stickers
- * clear quilting ruler
- * Sakura Pigma Micron .08
- * Sakura Koi Watercolor Set
- * paintbrush
- * 5 small shipping tags
- * jar of water
- * tape runner
- * pencil
- * white eraser
- * 9 photos cut to 2x2
- * Optional: heat gun, spray bottle of water



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use the watercolor paints to paint a soft and abstracted flower on the shipping tags. Use a very wet brush and allow the colors to blend. Let dry.
2. With a drier brush, add a second layer of color (more sparsely) to your flowers. Let dry.
3. Lay out tags and photos and then adhere them to your cardstock.
4. Lightly draw journaling lines with a ruler and pencil.
5. Add your journaling -- don't forget the date -- and erase the pencil lines.
6. Lay out your title on the edge of the quilting ruler. This helps you keep it straight and even. Apply the title to your layout and you're done!
