



Supplies:

Brother ScanNCut, cardstock, washi tape, buttons, stamps, spray ink, thread, and watercolors

Using up scraps of patterned paper or more of my washi tape is always a priority! My favorite use? Using my ScanNCut machine to cut out small shapes I create unique embellishments and use up my scraps – a double win!

Instructions:

1. Place scraps of paper or strips of washi tape onto cardstock and secure.
2. Cut out the images of your choice using the ScanNCut machine.
3. Adhere a 4 ¼ x 5 ½" piece of cardstock (with inked and stitched edges) to a 4 ¼ x 5 ½" folded card.
4. Spread a bit of watercolor across the bottom ½ of the card in the color of your choice.
5. Add a strip of washi tape across the middle and run some zig-zag stitching as well. Splatter some aqua and gold mist at this time as well.
6. Adhere three flowers and buttons to the card.
7. Finish the card by stamping hello and adding the wooden leaf embellishment.
