

Supplies:

Sewing machine, cardstock, stickers, Brother ScanNCut, paint, patterned paper, pen,

buttons, and sequins

I love adding a party feel to my projects with a banner, but pre-made embellishments can be so expensive! One solution? I make my own! Hand cutting can take a long time so I like to design my own and cut them out from scraps using my ScanNCut machine.

Instructions:

- 1. Draw an arc on a piece of paper. Then draw the banner pieces you want to add. Don't want to free-hand? You could make marks with a ruler or cut out a template and use it for each banner part.
- 2. Scan into the ScanNCut and save to the machine.
- 3. Place scrap(s) of patterned paper onto your ScanNCut mat. Load the saved pattern (multiple times if you would like several banners) and cut.
- 4. For the card background, stamp a sentiment with white paint and let dry. Then spray with colored mists and dab off the excess.



- 5. Stamp 'celebrate' with pink paint, let dry, then use ScanNCut to directly cut out the word.
- 6. To assemble this card, first place the banners and then stitch around the edges. Then place the 'celebrate' on foam adhesive and adhere, along with other stickers, buttons, and sequins.
- 7. To finish this $(4 \% \times 5 \%)$ card mount your card front onto a folded piece of cardstock.



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
