



Supplies:

Brother ScanNCut, cardstock, patterned paper, buttons and rhinestones, stamps, doily, thread, watercolors, and ink

Coloring stamped images is one of my favorite things to do. Taking time to carefully color is a lot of fun, but taking time to cut it out and make it the focus of a card? Not so much! For this project I used the ScanNCut to quickly scan and then cut my cute image, and then I was able to make a card with this lovely bunny as a focal point.

Instructions:

1. Use watercolors, pencils, pens, or any other color medium of your choice to color your stamped image onto heavy white cardstock.
2. Scan and then cut out the stamp image using the ScanNCut machine.
3. Adhere a 4 x 5 ¼" piece of patterned paper (with inked edges) to a 4 ¼ x 5 ½" folded card.
4. Add a piece of lace and doily to the patterned paper, then stitch them into place. Stitch around the edges of the patterned paper twice.
5. Use foam adhesive to place the stamped image onto the cards.
6. Add buttons and rhinestones to the card.
7. Finish the card by adding "love" stamped with black paint so that it stands out and will stamp over any textured or stitched areas.
