



# <u>Gelatin Print</u> <u>Stamping</u>

#### Supplies:

- Gelli Arts<sup>®</sup> gel printing plate
- Acrylic stamping block
- Acrylic paints
- Brayer
- Cardstock
  - Paper trimmer
  - The Crafters Workshop stencils
- ➢ Ex. Circled Face mask − TCW2065
- \*any small masks will work

#### Directions:

- 1. Place gel plate onto acrylic stamping block with gel plate facing up.
- 2. Apply a small amount of 2-3 colors paint onto the gel plate and spread out the paint using a small brayer.
- 3. Lay small stencil/mask across painted gel plate.
- 4. Carefully pick up acrylic block and stamp onto cardstock. Carefully lift away.
- 5. Repeat this process 2-3 times until no paint remains around stencil on gel plate, moving quickly so that paint does not dry on gel plate.
- 6. Remove the stencil exposing paint under stencil.
- 7. Carefully pick up acrylic block and stamp onto cardstock.
- 8. The first and last prints create the most dramatic images. Use to create greeting cards or any mixed media piece.
