

RAINBOW METALLIC WRITING

Pick a word that you can do in script.

Practice writing the word with the lower case letters approximately 1" high.

Keep the letters connected, but spaced far apart from each other.

After you are done practicing, get your black paper, and using (Sakura's) silver metallic Gelly Roll, write the word on the black paper.

If there is an ascender or descender in the word, you can flourish it. If there isn't, you can add a flourish underneath the word.

Once you have your word written in a smooth silver stroke on black paper, get the other metallic Gelly Roll colors, and put them in rainbow order.

Take the first color and draw a line on either side of the first letter. Then fill the top part in with that color, leaving the bottom part outlined.

Take the second color and fill in the bottom part of the letter, and trace over the stroke which joins that letter to the next letter.

Take the third color and draw lines on either side of the second letter.

Repeat until you have completed the word.

TIPS: The wider your letters, the more impact you'll get from the metallic.

Don't be afraid to blend colors.

On the flourishes, you can go in opposite rainbow order for maximum 'wow' factor.
