



# <u>Groovy Stenciled</u> Pi<u>llow</u>

### Supplies:

- Canvas Corp<sup>™</sup> 14" round pillow case
- Fairfield World<sup>™</sup> 14" round pillow
- Acrylic paints
- Art-C<sup>™</sup> The Groove<sup>™</sup> Tool
- The Crafters Workshop stencil
  - Geo Explosion TCW544

#### Directions:

- 1. Place a scrap piece of cardboard or cereal box inside pillow case to protect paint from going through and to give you a smooth surface to paint on.
- 2. Place stencil onto pillow case. You can tape the stencil down for more stability.
- 3. Pour a small amount of 2-3 colors paint paint palette.
- 4. Using stencil brush attachment on The Groove<sup>™</sup> Tool, dip into a small amount of paint with tool turned on high speed.
- 5. With brush still moving, brush paint over stencil onto the pillow case using The Groove<sup>™</sup> Tool. Dip tool back into paint as necessary.
- 6. To change colors, you can swap out for a new brush head, or wash out brush head and towel dry.
- 7. Repeat this process until design is painted.
- 8. Remove the stencil and allow paint to dry.
- 9. Heat-set paint after dried or use a fabric medium mixed with acrylic paint to make the pillow case washable.
- 10. Insert pillow and enjoy!
