

Supplies:

Sewing machine, cardstock, stickers, Brother ScanNCut, ink, blending tool, pen, and

sequins

No thread? No problem! Use your sewing machine to add texture to any paper craft project. Ink, stitching, pen work, and stamps are all great ways to create a lot of depth without bulk or weight on your project.

Instructions:

- 1. Draw a series of circles (random, different sizes) and scan into ScanNCut. Cut out from cardstock to create your own stencil.
- 2. Use various colors of ink and mist with the homemade stencil to create layers of color.
- 3. Using a sewing machine, turn your project so the back side is up and stitch as desired. Remember to remove the thread so that holes are punched. A larger stitch is best so that there is space between the holes

Tip: Make a mark or line on the back where you want to stitch if you're not sure where you want the lines to be.

- 4. Ink over the edges and holes where stitching/punctures are to add contrast.
- 5. Add pen lines around the edges
- 6. Add sticker and leaf accents
- 7. To finish the card, add sequins and flecks of gold mist.





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
